



2010 Oregon President's Cup

Playing dates:

Preliminary rounds: April 3, 10, 11, 17, 18

Semi finals – April 24 @ Tualatin Hills Rec Center or PCC – Rock Creek

Finals – April 25 @ Tualatin Hills Rec Center

Formats:

Boys Under 15: 4 teams – group play with the top 2 teams advancing to the final

Boys Under 16: 6 teams – 2 groups of 3 with the top 2 teams in each group advancing to the semi-finals. Winners of the semi final games will advance to the finals

Boys Under 17: 4 teams – this age group is combined with the 2 Under 18 teams for preliminary round play. All 4 teams will advance to the semi-final round and the winners of the semi final games will advance to the finals

Boys Under 18: 2 teams – this age group is combined with the 4 Under 17 teams for the preliminary rounds and then both teams advance to the final

Girls Under 15: 8 teams – 2 groups of 4 teams playing 3 preliminary round games, top 2 teams in each group advance to the semi finals and the winners of the semi-final games advance to the finals

Girls Under 16: 5 teams – group play with the top 2 teams advancing to the finals

Girls Under 17: 7 teams – 1 group of 4 with each team playing 3 games and 1 group of 3 with each team playing 2 games. Top 2 teams from each age group will advance to the semi-finals. Winners of the semi-final games will advance to the finals.

Girls Under 18: 4 teams – group play with the top 2 teams advancing to the finals.

The Oregon Presidents Cup champions for U13 – U17 advance to the 2010 Region IV Presidents Cup, June 13 – 20 in Medford, Oregon. In addition, Oregon received wildcards at Boy's Under 17 and Girl's Under 15 so the finalist in these age groups will also attend.
